These foreign chapters will also translate and be allowed to modify the official SASS Handbook to accommodate the different laws, regulations, and restrictions affecting their own country.

## TERRITORIAL GOVERNOR SUMMIT VOTING PROCESS BINDING OR NOT?

There are two sides to every story. In the case of the Territorial Governor Summit voting procedures, there's no exception.

Those who attended the 1999 Summit in Las Vegas were given the responsibility of a binding vote. The general feeling of the attendees was "we came here to accomplish something and what good is our attendance if we can't make decisions?"

On the other hand, non-attending Governors expressed concern it might not be fair to rely solely on the vote of the attending percentage of Territorial Governors who made the pilgrimage to Las Vegas.

SASS believes Governors attending the Summit do need to make decisions, and they will therefore continue to be asked to vote and shape our future by representing the needs of their constituent club members and providing SASS with advice, guidance, and support.

To make it fair for all Governors to represent their constituents, decisions made by majority voting at the Annual Territorial Governor Summit will stand, but will not be binding until the entire Territorial Governor body has seen the final voting results and been given the opportunity voice the opinions of their members with a simple agree/disagree response in the Territorial Bulletin.

Rule modifications and changes, firearm approval, and other issues requiring the decision making input of the Territorial Governors will take place annually at the Territorial Governor Summit. Discussions of these issues will continue to be addressed and added to the annual agenda from the results of Governor meetings at END of TRAIL, Winter Range, and all seven SASS Regionals.

Governors are reminded they represent the members of the clubs that appoint or elect them. Opinions of Governors are assumed to represent their constituents and not the individual Governor.
