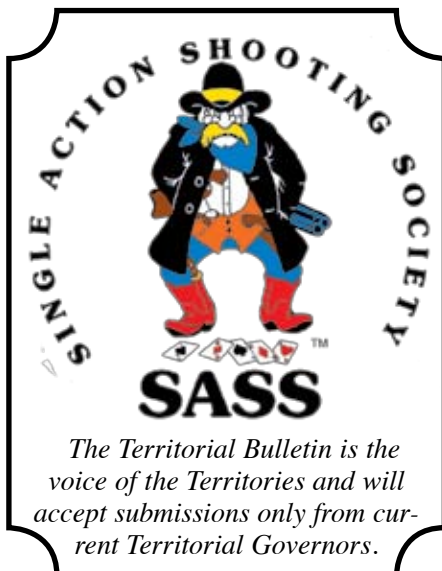
It is that time of year again, time to do your SASS Club Renewal. Once again it has never been easier. There are two ways your club may renew its affiliation.

END of TRAIL 2008

Minutes

June 18, 2008

Presiding: Coyote Calhoun

Wild Bunch Attending: Coyote Calhoun,
Hipshot, Tex

Coyote Calhoun welcomed and thanked all in attendance. The following items were discussed during the meeting:

1. The 1887 external modification requested by Manatee was reviewed by the RO Committee and determined it to be outside the rules and therefore illegal.

2. The definition of an open action was given as "safely open" as determined by the Timer Operator.

3. Frangible bullets were discussed as being tested for feasibility. If determined to be feasible, additional information and research will follow as it becomes available.

4. The intent of the Wild Bunch Match rules was explained. The rules as currently written, with minor changes, will remain intact. These rules are only intended for use as a side match at END of TRAIL. Other clubs can adopt the SASS rules or make changes as desired at their own matches.

5. Black Jack Zak was recognized to give an update on his research on modifying the current category structure. The idea is to modify the current "traditional style" categories by combining those categories and then sub-dividing by age and gender. For example, the current Modern, Traditional, and 49er categories would be collapsed into one group then sub-divided by age as appropriate. Quite a bit of conversation was offered from the floor about potential age breaks, logistics, and economics of the multi-

tude of categories currently offered.

6. Enforcement of current rules was discussed and strongly encouraged at all levels of SASS matches in order to promote more consistency.

7. Discussion from the floor was heard about the possibility of adding .22 caliber pocket pistols as legal for side matches. There was no clear majority in attendance either in favor of or opposed to this issue.

8. Discussion from the floor was heard on the possibility of removing the current minor safety penalty for loading more rounds than required by the stage description. The majority in attendance were opposed to this idea.

9. It was agreed an agenda item for the 2008 TG Summit will be added to potentially remove the current penalty for retrieving dropped ammo from a table after completing a stage.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:00 p.m.

TERRITORIAL GOVERNOR SUMMIT AGENDA

- 1. Should we combine the Traditional and Modern categories and then split this combination into two age-based categories, with the age breaks being at 17 and up / 36 and up? This would give us age-based categories for all ages. All age based categories would allow the use of all SASS legal firearms, propellants and shooting styles except Gunfighter.
- 2. Should we allow the use of the Gunfighter shooting style in all age-based categories except the Buckaroo and Junior categories?
- 3. Should we replace the line – “Outlawed - Clothing displaying manufacturer’s or sponsor’s logos” with “The displaying of sponsor’s or team logos on apparel or equipment is prohibited. Manufacturer’s labels on such apparel or equipment are acceptable.”?
- 4. Stage Conventions Item #3 requires all long guns staged horizontally shall be staged lying flat where at least the rear of the trigger guard is on the staging area. Should this also be applied to handguns?
- 5. Should we clarify the costuming requirements as follows? “ALL Clothing MUST BE worn appropriately, how it was intended and how it would have been worn in the OLD WEST or as seen on B-Western movies and Television. Clothing that is clearly NOT in the spirit of the “Old West” or in good taste is NOT allowed.”
- 6. Should we allow a shooter to retrieve a dropped round? The current rule actually assumes that a safety rule could potentially occur when retrieving dropped rounds. We have rules in place that address safety issues when they occur.
- 7. Should we change the verbiage about de-cocking a firearm from - De-cocking a revolver, rifle, or external hammer shotgun may not be done with a live round under the hammer. De-cocking may not be done to avoid a penalty if cocked at the wrong time or position. to - NO gun may be de-cocked on the firing line except by pointing it down-range and pulling the trigger or while under the direct supervision of a stage officer.
- 8. Should we change the rule regarding empties left on the carrier or in the chamber of a long gun? A live round in the chamber would continue to carry a Stage Disqualification penalty and a live round on the carrier a 10-second minor safety. This change would eliminate all penalties for empty rounds in the chamber or on the carrier of long guns only.
- 9. Should we allow gunfighters to carry revolvers in the butt forward manner? We have rules in place that address safety issues when they occur.
- 10. Should we allow ejectors on single shot shotguns?
- 11. Should we add the following verbiage to address aerial shotgun targets for Buckaroos and Buckaretttes? “Buckaroos and Buckaretttes must shoot at (engage) all aerial shotgun targets unless alternate targets are provided. Aerial targets will be scored as “hit” if fired at before the target impacts the ground. Targets that hit the ground before being fired at will be scored as a “miss”.

SASS MOUNTED TERRITORIAL GOVERNORS AND ADVISORY COMMITTEE SUMMIT

The SASS Mounted Territorial Governors and Advisory Committee Summit will begin its meetings on Friday December 7th at the 7th Annual SASS Convention. The Friday meeting is scheduled to begin at 9:00 AM and last until Noon. The second day of the meeting is scheduled for Saturday December the 8th at 9:00Am and continue until Noon.

Although the agenda is not complete at this time below are a few of the item that will be discussed.

- 1) The maximum time on a stage shall be 60 seconds.
- 2) There shall be a 5 second penalty for a knocked over gate cone
- 3) SASS recognizes the highest ranking Male and Female from the state or region at SASS Sanctioned State, and Regional Championship matches as the

state and regional champion. Should the geographical limits placed on the residency of any competitor be eliminated? If so, should a compeditor be able to win more than one championship? Who should get the free entry to the Regionals and National Championships?

- 4) SASS will recognize the highest level a competitor achieves in any organization with a classification system similar to SASS.

The Match Management & Scoring System

The Match Management & Scoring System uses MS Access as its database engine. Since the install program includes the MS Access runtime module you won't need to purchase any additional software.

If you own MS Word the Match Management & Scoring System will extract mail merges for name and address labels. You can create your own specialized match certificates and the system will merge category winners into these templates.

During annual or regional matches you can track many different criteria, such as: dinner tickets, gun cart rentals, registration input (whether your registrations come from your web site, regular mail, e-mail, etc).

The Vendor registration module includes space management and tracking of payments and sponsorship fees. This module also prints vendor badges and dinner tickets.

The Match Management & Scoring System is capable of scoring by rank points, total time or category total time just by selecting the check box you want.

You're also able to track misses, penalties and bonuses so shooter can track their progress.


Annual Support
