- 2- Be accepted or enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student at an accredited institution of higher education actively pursuing an academic or trade discipline.
- 3- Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES & INFORMATION

_____ **Part I: Application** – Complete the official SASS® Scholarship Application form

_____ **Part II: Resume** – Prepare and submit a professional resume. Refer to the format template provided in this packet to compose your resume. It is important to include supporting documents such as recommendations, articles, certificates, testimonials, and media from leadership in school, on the shooting range, extracurricular activities, and any academic achievements that demonstrate your motivation to serve and succeed.

_____ **Part III: Essay** – submit a 300-500-word essay on the specified topic. Essay must be double spaced with the title at the top, and each page must contain your name, SASS Alias and SASS number.

Academic Year 2020/2021 Applicants Essay Topic:

A mentor is defined as an experienced and trusted advisor. Select an Old West frontiersman or woman whom you respect enough to have trusted as a mentor. What would s/he have shared with you about her/his career path? What guidance would s/he have provided? How would the role modeling and advice s/he would have provided during her/his lifetime be beneficial to you today?

_____ **Part IV: Acceptance letter/Letter of intent – A):** First time college students must supply a copy of the acceptance letter to the college/university/trade school to which you applied as evidence of your acceptance. **OR- B):** Renewing applicants or current college students must supply a GPA from the most recent semester and a list of classes for the coming semester/academic year.

_____ **Part V: Transcripts** – High School students should attach a high school transcript (Spring 2020), first time college and renewing students may supply an unofficial fall semester/quarter, 2019 transcript. If your college has not sent out an acceptance letter by the time you have submitted your application, please submit a letter stating this, then submit a copy once it is received.

_____ **Part VI: Letters of Recommendation-** Application must include 3 letters of recommendation. (no more/no less) from any of the following: fellow SASS members, teacher/professor, community leader, or employer. *No letters from immediate family or SASS employees will be accepted.

_____ **Part VII: Photographs** – submit no more than 3 photos- one color print in full Cowboy attire wearing your SASS® badge, and a high-resolution PDF or JPG format for *The Cowboy Chronicle*.

Please make sure the application is complete with all parts included. Incomplete or partial applications will not be accepted.
