ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible to apply for consideration for a scholarship from the SASS® Scholarship Foundation, the following criteria must be met:

- 1- Be an active SASS member for at least one year.
- 2- Be accepted or enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student at an accredited institution of higher education actively pursuing an academic or trade discipline.
- 3- Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The deadline for submission for the academic year **2026/2027 is May 1, 2026**. Your completed application mailing must be postmarked by the deadline date. **Electronic applications are not accepted.** Always ensure that all communication contains your full name, SASS number, alias, mailing address, email address, and daytime phone number.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES & INFORMATION

Part I: Application – Complete the official SASS® Scholarship Application form

Part II: Resume – Prepare and submit a professional resume. Refer to the format template provided in this packet to compose your resume. It is important to include supporting documents such as recommendations, articles, certificates, testimonials, and media from leadership in school, on the shooting range, extracurricular activities, and any academic achievements that demonstrate your motivation to serve and succeed.

Part III: Essay – submit a 300-500-word essay on the specified topic. Essay must be double spaced with the title at the top, and each page must contain your name, SASS Alias and SASS number.

Academic Year 2026/2027 Applicants Essay Prompt:

The Impact of the Cowboy Code

The Cowboy Code is built on principles such as courage, integrity, accountability, loyalty, and respect—values that guide individuals in both personal and professional life.

In an essay, explain how the Cowboy Code has influenced who you are today. Discuss specific principles such as living each day with courage, taking pride in your work, finishing what you start, keeping your promises, being tough but fair, and knowing where to draw the line. Describe how these values have shaped your character, work ethic, and decision-making, and how they will continue to guide you as you pursue your education and future goals.

Support your response with personal examples and reflections that demonstrate how you live out these principles in your daily life and the impact that they have had in your life.

Part IV: Acceptance letter/Letter of intent – A): First time college students must supply a copy of the acceptance letter to the college/university/trade school to which you applied as evidence of your acceptance. **OR-B):** Renewing applicants or current college students must supply a GPA from the most recent semester and a list of classes for the coming semester/academic year.

Part V: Transcripts – High School students should attach a high school transcript (Spring 2023), first time college and renewing students may supply an unofficial fall semester/quarter, 2022 transcript. If your college has not sent out an acceptance letter by the time you have submitted your application, please submit a letter stating this, then submit a copy once it is received.

Part VI: Letters of Recommendation- Application must include 3 letters of recommendation. (no more/no less) from any of the following: fellow SASS members, teacher/professor, community leader, or employer. *No letters from immediate family or SASS employees will be accepted.

Part VII: Photographs – submit at least one, but no more than 3 photos- photos must be full color in full Cowboy attire wearing your SASS® badge clearly visible (A “head shot” with your SASS badge on your chest is preferred). A minimum size of 5 x 7 in a high-resolution printed copy must be included in your application. No email submissions will be accepted.

Please make sure the application is complete with all parts included. Incomplete or partial applications will not be accepted.
